# **SHARING OUR TREASURES: June Update**

In May, our income exceeded our expenses by \$19,642. This improved our year-to-date increase in cash to \$9,217. This amount had been running at a deficit for the first four months of this year so this is, without a doubt, good news and should be celebrated! It is important to point out though that this substantial increase in income was the result of a generous one-time bequest of \$23,000 from the estate of a deceased member of the church. Without this bequest we would have had a shortfall of \$3,358 last month. While we celebrate the gain, let us be prayerful and intentional about what we can do to continue moving forward in this positive direction!

As noted in last month's report, as attendance decreases during the summer months, the church's operating expenses continue. Let us continue to consider the various methods of sustained and automatic giving. Your generous support is a blessing to Zion and is greatly appreciated and necessary. Thank you!

As God's gifts continue to flow to us, let us each ask: What are the positive ways God's commitment to us and his creation impact us? How can we respond to His love for us?

- Learn how to interact with a person in crisis and

Youth Mental Health First Aid is primarily designed for adults who regularly interact with young people. This training is designed to teach family members, teachers, school staff, neighbors, youth pastors, health and human services workers, and other caring citizens how to help an adolescent (ages 12-18) who is experiencing a mental health or addiction challenge or crisis.

During this training, you will:

- Identify common signs and symptoms of mental health challenges, including anxiety, depression, eating disorders, and ADHD
- Recognize common signs and symptoms of substance use challenges
- Learn how to interact with a child or adolescent in crisis and connect them with help
- Be introduced to expanded content on trauma, substance use, self-care, and the impact of social media and bullying
